Anwar one of his friends told him, “You have to perform kaffara. It is not enough for you to perform one sawm instead of your broken sawm”.

- a. What is Qaza in Sawm?
- b. What is Makrooh Sawm?
- c. Explain the fasting of Mr. Arif?
- d. Evaluate the statement of Mr. Anwar in the light of your text.

2. Rahat Ali has been suffering a lot of problems and loss in his trade. Recently he has gone to a majar in Sylhet and prayed to the departed peer and made some vow of charity. His friend, Hashem Khan, told him to be dependent on Allah with hope and faith patiently. He added that, this is a great and unpardonable sin.
